Description

Diamond, ruby and diamond solitaire ring - 18 carat gold, circa 1970 Superb ring featuring a central old-cut diamond of approximately 2.20 carats, mounted in solitaire, flanked by two natural rubies of approximately 0.20 carats each. The main stone, estimated quality VVS2 to VS1 and color G-H, offers exceptional brilliance and a particularly lively old cut. The setting, in 18 carat yellow gold (750 ?), adopts an elegant spiral design where two arms set with seven diamonds each (approximately 0.18 carats per row) highlight the central diamond and frame the rubies. Work from the 1970s, this modern setting highlights the old stone, creating a jewel that is both refined and balanced. A small fixed bridge is present under the band, easily removable for size adjustment. A solid ring, beautifully crafted, with
