Description

MONTAGNE Louis Agricol (1879-1960) "The cliffs of Longues" Oil on canvas, Signed lower left, Titled on the back by the artist: "The cliffs of Longues (Calvados) - July 21, 1907", Studio number on the back: "510A", The Avignon painter Louis Agricol Montagné depicts here a path animated by an elegant woman with an umbrella descending to the cliffs of Longues-sur-Mer in Calvados in Normandy. Accustomed to the arid vegetation and the burning sun of Provence, the artist has succeeded here in perfectly recreating the atmosphere of the Normandy landscapes with green vegetation and the colors specific to this region. A student of Paul Sain and Cormon, he appeared at the Salon des Artistes français from 1901, where he received numerous awards during his

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participation. He exhibited very early in Avignon at the merchants Kassler and Mouret and realized at this period of decorative panels in collaboration with the painter Paul Sain. Wounded during the First World War, he lost an eye. This did not prevent him from leading a brilliant career. He was appointed director of the Ecole des Beaux-Arts d'Avignon from 1920 to 1928. Louis Agricol Montagné is part of the Group of 13.
