Paris porcelain from the Restoration period, early 19th century, 1820s. Unsigned, our sugar bowl is nevertheless of the same model, same profile, same handles as a sugar bowl signed by Schoelcher that we sold a few months ago, which encourages us to attribute it to this same manufacturer:

The Schoelcher Manufacture (1798-1834) is the heir to the Manufacture du Faubourg Saint Denis, formerly that of the Count of Artois, created under the Ancien Régime. It enjoyed great success under the Empire and the Restoration
