Type: Tsuba ajouré (sukashi)- Signature: Bushu ju Masayoshi (?????)· Schoolprobable: Bushu-Ito or related· Period: Late Edo (ca. 1800-1860)· Material: Carved patinated iron· Reason: Iris or paulownia (kiri) foliage
Inscription (mei?): visible on the faceflat near the nakago-ana (opening for the blade tang). The characters are:???? (Bushuju Masayoshi)this translates to "Masayoshi, resident of Bushu (Musashi province)".Bushu (??) corresponds to the current Tokyo/Saitama region. Several blacksmiths and tsuba craftsmen there haveworked between the 17th and 19th centuries, notably members of Bushu-Ito schoolsand Bushu-Masayoshi. The style with an openwork vegetable pattern, with neat reliefand to dense iron, corresponds well to the end of the Edo
