He was rejected ten years in a row at the Salon, from 1893 to 1903. After the war, he found his style, a skillful pastiche of Impressionism, thanks to which he took his revenge at the Salon des Artistes Français, winning numerous awards. His landscapes, briskly executed with small brushstrokes and the wet greens of a postcard Normandy, seduce with their rural subjects and
