It is hallmarked: . EP with a penknife for Puiforcat (only on the knife).. Minerva hallmark, 1st quality, before 1973 for 950/°° silver. Superb carving set, one of the most beautiful and sought-after Art Nouveau models, by one of the greatest silversmiths of this period.
