Charming pair of solid silver soliflore vases. The vases rest on a small circular pedestal. The cone-shaped body is made of plain silver. Each piece is hallmarked: . Lion passant for English solid silver. Leopard's head for the City of London. Date letter c for 1898-1899.

Silversmith's mark CE, probably for Charles Edwards, active from 1879 to 1884. A very pretty pair of small vases to adorn a beautiful Christmas table. 8.3 cm high 4.4 cm diameter at the base 60.6 grams. They are not weighted. Good condition.
