Description

This superb antique 17th-century safe lock is a true testament to the exceptional craftsmanship of the time. What makes this key even more fascinating is its pierced ring in the shape of a heart or spade, a rare feature that gives it an almost modern charm. This detail, both poetic and technical, reminds us that even utilitarian objects could be imbued with symbols and emotions, reflecting the artistic sensibility of the craftsmen of the time. The lock itself, specially designed for a safe, is equipped with three auberonnières, a complex mechanism for the time, which considerably reinforced security. This system, today considered a masterpiece of mechanics, testifies to the technological advance of 17th-century locksmiths, capable of designing devices as ingenious as they are aesthetic. Its generous dimensions, 18.5 x 11 cm, make it an imposing piece, while remaining delicately crafted. The engraved motifs, although discreet, add an additional touch of elegance, proving that utility did not necessarily have to exclude beauty. Each element of this lock, from the most visible to the most hidden, is the result of meticulous work, where each detail has been designed to combine strength and visual harmony. The patina of time, visible on the metal, adds a historical dimension to this piece, making it much more than just an object: it is a tangible fragment of the past, a direct link to the craftsmen who created it. To own such a lock is to own a piece of history, an object that has survived the centuries while retaining its integrity and charm.
