Description

Beautiful glazed terracotta depicting a young girl watching over geese. The work is signed by Henri Paul Rey, a French sculptor born in Pesmes in 1904. Rey studied at the École des Beaux-Arts in Besançon and at the École Nationale Supérieure des Beaux-Arts, where he learned to work with metal, wood, and ceramics. He exhibited his sculptures at the Salon de Paris (gold medal in 1937, silver in 1933, and bronze in 1932) as well as abroad, notably in New York. His works can be admired in museums in France, the United States, Canada, and Poland. Henri-Paul Rey passed away in 1981 and was a second-generation Cubist. In his works, he focused on form, volume, and impact. His subtle sculptures include busts -- portraits of famous people, anonymous representations, and religious figures. Source:
