The cabinet's belt is carved in an ogee pattern, bringing a visual softness to the whole. The two doors are finely molded, framed with blackened wooden fillets that elegantly highlight their contours. The solid plinth is enhanced in its upper part by an ogee molding, echoing the belt and reinforcing the harmony of the design. Inside, the sideboard is equipped with an adjustable shelf mounted on racks, allowing for flexible organization according to needs. This piece of furniture, which combines functionality and
