Jaap Stellaart (1920-1992) established himself as an abstract painter and draftsman with a unique and experimental style shortly after the Second World War. In the 1950s, he joined the post-Cobra group Creatie and exhibited in the United States and abroad with artists such as Karel Appel, Armando, Eugene Brands, Corneille, and Anton Rooskens. Stellaart was a very introverted man; he aspired to reach as many people as possible with his art, but he was largely disconnected from the art world, its major exhibitions, its
