Important garden fountain in patinated terracotta representing an allegory of summer. It consists of a young woman in a drape falling over her legs, wearing a crown of wheat and carrying a jar. At her side, a dolphin's head forming a spout and, in the lower part, a cornucopia forming a basin. Our fountain rests on its original terracotta base. Period circa 1920. Signature at the bottom of the sculpture, on the right, Ezio CECCARELLI. Excellent condition.
