Charles-Euphrasie Kuwasseg was a French painter known for his landscapes and especially his seascapes. Son of the Austrian-born French painter Karl Joseph Kuwasseg, he grew up in an artistic environment where he learned drawing and painting at a very young age. From 1855 onwards, he exhibited regularly at the Paris Salon. His canvases often depict the coasts of Brittany, Normandy, or the North Sea, and sometimes also river landscapes enlivened by boats and everyday figures. His style is both realistic and poetic: he meticulously rendered the effects of light, the reflections on the water, and
