An elegant pair of 14-karat gold and silver drop earrings, early 20th century (circa 1900-1920). A circular, scalloped setting, each earring is centered by a rose-cut diamond surrounded by a ring of rose-cut diamonds. The contrast between the diamonds' brilliance and the pale surface of the front silver, combined with the 14-karat gold backing, testifies to the refined workmanship of the era. A period clasp, original setting, and timeless elegance make these earrings a refined example of Belle Époque jewelry.
