These traditional Japanese masks occupy an important place in Japanese culture. Each mask has a specific meaning! An embodiment of anger! Or a demon! And others. Often made from a single piece of cypress wood, covered with white lead, then colored and lacquered. Horsehair serves as hair or facial hair! Painted with India ink. This particular mask is very beautiful, depicting a character with a mustache and goatee! A very expressive face. In very good condition! Dimensions: 18 cm high (34 cm including the goatee), 12 cm wide, and 8 cm deep. A visually magnificent antique piece!
