### Description

Patinated Bronze Salamander - France, circa 1880-1900. A beautiful, finely chiseled bronze salamander, resting flat, with a brown patina nuanced with golden highlights. Description: High-quality sand casting, realistically rendering the scaly texture of the skin and the details of the legs. Underneath, traces of old gilding and natural wear to the patina. French work from the late 19th century, probably intended to adorn a desk as a paperweight or as a cabinet of curiosities object. Dimensions: 27 cm x 20 cm. Condition: Very good antique condition, with wear consistent with age and a beautiful patina. This naturalistic yet somewhat stylized salamander reflects the vogue for decorative naturalism (bronze animals, insects, reptiles) around 1880-1910, linked to Art Nouveau and Japonist
