Earthenware Virgin of Childbirth, probably from Nevers. The Virgin of Childbirth is a statuette frequently found in homes from the 18th to the 19th centuries. On the Virgin's head is a hollowed-out crown with a two-centimeter diameter hole at the bottom. Holy water could be poured through this hole, and more importantly, a candle could be placed inside to be lit when the woman went into labor. Regarding condition, there are some minor chips, firing flaws, and typical signs of wear and rubbing for this type of object. Our photos allow you to appreciate the quality of the piece.
