Patrice Allard -- Kinetic Tapestry, School of Vasarely -- Circa 1970 A dazzling wool tapestry signed by Patrice Allard, created around 1970, in the style of the School of Vasarely and the Op Art movement. This remarkably precise geometric work plays on the superimposition of interlocking volumes and skillfully orchestrated gradations, ranging from saffron yellow to olive green to deep gray. The rigor of the forms and the vibrancy of the colors create an impression of movement and depth, typical of the kinetic art of the period. Woven entirely in wool, the surface reveals a subtle, textured relief, lending the piece a warmth rarely found in Op Art. Mounted on a black background and framed in dark wood, this iconic piece combines technical mastery with timeless modernity. Dimensions: 80 × 80 cm
