Description

This miniature portrait depicts a tavern drinker, typical of the 17th century. Regarding the artist, we found a name written in pencil on the back: "Brouwer". We cannot be certain who the painter is, as the painting is unsigned; however, after searching on sites such as Artprice, the style strongly suggests Adriaen Brouwer. We are not discussing attribution, nor are we definitively identifying the painter. Adriaen Brouwer (1605-1638) was a painter and draughtsman from the Southern Netherlands specializing in genre scenes. Brouwer primarily painted tavern and tobacco-shop scenes, bringing a decisive renewal to genre painting based on older examples of Brueghelian rusticity, but with an incomparable technical refinement that elevates these Flemish "roughings" to truly dramatic and moving
