The coat, waistcoat, and breeches are made of midnight-blue cut silk velvet, complete with their original faceted steel buttons with diamond points and fully lined in cream satin. In addition to the bicorn hat--taupe with moiré ribbons and steel facings--the set includes a second cream satin waistcoat, a lace jabot and pair of gloves, as well as a pair of leather shoes marked Pearl & Co. of London (the leather is patinated and slightly worn). The breeches are labeled Randall & Walls of Bristol and marked J. Weston. Stevens. Esa, the owner's name. No flaws to report.
