The front opens with two grilled doors, adorned with chased and gilded bronze mounts. The top is made of Sainte-Anne grey marble. The interior has three shelves, ideal for displaying objects or books. The cabriole legs have slight offsets, typical of the transition between the Louis XV and Louis XVI styles.
