The slightly conical lampshade, covered in beige fabric with decorative trim, is height-adjustable thanks to an ingenious mechanism. This allows the light to be adapted to suit different needs, while maintaining the aesthetic harmony of the room. Topped with a laurel wreath, this lamp combines functionality and prestige.
