Original drawing depicting the Rhine Falls below Laufen Castle. In the foreground, a couple in a boat and a figure waving to them from the riverbank. "This castle is listed in the Swiss Inventory of Cultural Property of National and Regional Importance. It is built on rocks from which the Rhine plunges from a height of over 20 meters, over a width of 100 meters, between Bohnenberg Hill, near the Neuhaasen Gorge, and Kohlfirst Hill, northeast of Laufen Castle."
