This playful yet ergonomic armchair perfectly illustrates the Norwegian designer's pursuit of balance, movement, and bodily freedom. Nicknamed "Globe Garden," the model is distinguished by its organic silhouette and spherical volumes reminiscent of a planetary system. A true icon of postmodern furniture, it stands at the crossroads of functional design and contemporary sculpture.
