Iranian kilim from the Fars region (southwest Iran), wool, circa 1960. Good condition. Some signs of wear. On a plain red 'kazade' and abraché (a term describing variations in tone within the same color) background, eight medallions frame five butterflies. Various colored and stylized borders enhance this authentic kilim. The Gashghai confederation comprises different tribes. Some examples: the Bozorg Kashkuli (the tall ones), the Kuchek Kashkuli (the short ones), the Shishboluki (six districts), and the Amaleh or Yalameh (workers, servants of the Khan).
