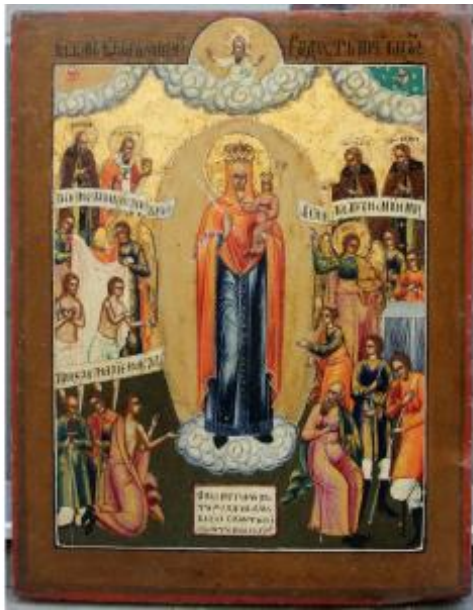

It depicts the Most Holy Mother of God, Joy of All the Afflicted. Acquired from the Mikael Gallery in Strasbourg in the 1980s. Inscriptions: in ecclesiastical Cyrillic. Technique: oil and gold leaf on wood. Dimensions: 17.5 x 22.5 cm.

Condition: some flaking of the gilding, damage to the upper and lower right corners.
