Here we find the distinctive style of George Goodwin Kilburne and his watercolor technique. The size of this watercolor is remarkable for a work by this artist. On the back is a (partial) label of "Wilkinson & Son" in Sheffield. Dimensions: Watercolor: 52 x 36 cm; Frame: 74 x 61 cm. George Goodwin Kilburne, [RI, ROI, RMS, (July 24, 1839 - 1924 London)] was an English genre painter specializing in accurately depicted interiors with figures. He favored watercolor, although he also worked in oil and pencil and initially trained as a wood engraver.
