This 18th-century walnut armchair, Venice, is an authentic example of refined Venetian wood culture. In excellent overall condition, with a splendid patina, it measures 68x59xh116 cm, seat height 50 cm. This proportion is important, because it makes the armchair not only aesthetically significant, but also comfortable and properly balanced for present-day use. Moreover, the curve of the arms, the sinuous secondary elements and the walnut selection -- dense and well-seasoned -- clearly reveal a highly skilled hand.

Venetian walnut is famous because it combines material elegance and chromatic depth.

Therefore, even if the forms are essential, the visual effect is rich. Furthermore, the movement of the wood -- smooth and compact -- tells

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centuries of care, and above all transmits that emotional continuity that only antique furniture can communicate. Since every detail is still full and alive, this armchair expresses refinement and visual calm. In fact, whoever purchases such a piece acquires not only an object, but a fragment of true Venice -- cultural and intact in its language.
