Pair of glazed porcelain busts of children, Staffordshire, England, 20th C . A charming and rare pair of glazed porcelain busts depicting two children with delicately modeled faces, typical of Victorian Romanticism. Each figure rests on a quadrangular base decorated with stylized crackle patterns enhanced with red and blue lines, reminiscent of the marbling of continental porcelain. The young boy, with full features and a pensive gaze, is dressed in a midnight blue coat with white lapels, punctuated with touches of red and gold, in a palette evoking 19th-century children's formal uniforms. His light brown hair is finely painted, framing a softly modeled and expressive face. The young girl, wearing a bonnet with a pink ribbon and ruffled edges, sports a navy blue dress with a white collar, tied with a

delicate pink bow. Her blond curls and translucent complexion are reminiscent of idealized childhood portraits in English painting of the period. The piece is captivating thanks to the quality of its glossy glaze, the delicacy of the modeling, and the naive elegance of the composition. These busts, likely intended to adorn a mantelpiece or shelf in a bourgeois home, reflect the Victorian taste for sentimental and decorative representations of childhood.
