She married on June 10, 1883 in Paris Mr. François Paul Raoul Loiseau, lawyer at the Paris Court of Appeal. Three children were born from this union, two girls and a boy. Marie Loiseau was a student of Mademoiselle Espérance Langlois (active between 1860 and 1890) and Pierre Dupuis (1833-1915). The artist was present at the Paris Salon: - under her maiden name in 1880 and 1882 with a genre scene then a portrait, - under her married name in 1884 and 1885 each time with a portrait.
