The three-door front is finished in a beautiful honey-toned moiré veneer, framed in a darker wood, with discreet metal handles. The design emphasizes volume and the nobility of the materials, in the Dominique style: clean lines, refined proportions, and meticulous craftsmanship. A chic and timeless piece for a living room or dining room, offering generous storage. Maison Dominique was founded in Paris in 1922 by André Domin and Marcel Genevière and distinguished itself among the leading French interior designers of the interwar period. Its modern and refined style favored fine veneers and
