His approach is purist, passionate, and enthusiastic, always seeking to convey emotions in his work, because he affirms that "design without soul is design without distinction." Claudio La Viola has worked for companies such as Agape, Falper, Rapsel, Richard Ginori, Viabizzuno, Zani&Zani, and Brix. Richard-Ginori, renamed Ginori 1735 in 2020, is a company created on October 11, 1896, from the merger of the Lombard-based Richard Ceramics Company with the Manifattura di Doccia of Marquis Carlo Ginori, founded in 1737 in the town of Doccia.
