Description

A charming English porcelain composition depicting a chaffinch perched on a branch, watching over its three eggs nestled in the hollow of its nest. Stamped "Crown Staffordshire England" under the base, it bears the inscription "Designed and modelled by JT Jones". The piece retains a label affixed to the base bearing the name of the renowned shop "Au Vase Étrusque, 11 place de la Madeleine à Paris" (At the Etruscan Vase, 11 Place de la Madeleine in Paris). Owned by Louis Damon from the late 19th century, the shop specialized in luxury tableware and decorative arts, primarily catering to an aristocratic and bourgeois clientele.
