An 18-karat rose and white gold brooch, adorned in the center with a tiger's eye depicting a man's profile in the Greco-Roman style. The upper section, in white gold, features three rose-cut diamonds. Overall, it is in good condition; note that there are four tiny chips around the edge of the tiger's eye. The brooch pin is wider than the brooch itself. Three hallmarks are present, including one with a dog's head, corresponding to the Tunisian hallmark "Slougui Dog Head". This is a hallmark for goldwork, in use since July 18, 1905, at the Tunis control office. Tunisian work, early 20th century. Dimensions: Weight: 7.75 grams; Length: 3.11 centimeters; Width: 2.3 centimeters at its widest point; Needle length: 2.57 centimeters; Tiger's eye diameter: 1.76 centimeters.
