Each generously curved base features a floral and foliate decoration in vibrant colors--royal blue, celadon green, saffron yellow, and burnt orange--emblematic of the ornamental refinement of the renowned Loire Valley pottery. The finely chased gilt bronze mounts, with rocaille and foliate motifs, elegantly frame the ceramics, highlighting their silhouette with a touch of Second Empire splendor.
