Double reliquary, in silver filigree, containing two relics ex ossibus of saints - Italy - 19th century. Description: Radiant presentation in gilt paper filigree, polychrome background, relics arranged in lozenge-shaped cartouches, with original handwritten bands: - S. Jo. Jos. a Cr.: Saint Joseph of the Cross (+1734), Discalced Carmelite, canonized in 1992. - S. Ulrani: Saint Ulric (Ulricus), bishop (very likely difficult to identify). The bone fragments are clearly visible. Reverse side closed by a large red wax seal with episcopal coats of arms, original silk threads unbroken. Dimensions: 8 cm x 6 cm. Condition: Complete, unopened, authentic and intact seal. Signs of wear and patina consistent with age, no bail. In accordance with canon law (can. 1190 §1), this sale concerns only the reliquary as a
