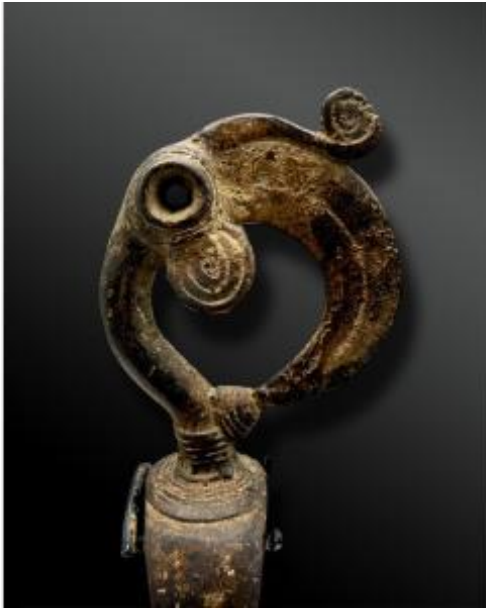

surrounded by concentric circles. The stirrup
forms the body of the animal and is decorated
