This German Sword is Circa 1530. The sword which is in excellent condition is very light, maneuverable and robust. The hilt is comprised of a crucifix form with twisted guard and twisted pommel. The handle is wood with leather wrapping which is likely been replaced over its long life. The guard itself displays some light play which is quiet light. The blade is a long double edged blade with single fuller, the blade condition is good having signs of age in the form of oxidation and some contact areas and some
