WEAVING LOOM PULLEY BRACKET with ANTHROPOMORPHIC FACE Baoulé/Djimini culture, Ivory Coast First half of the 20th century Wood and cord H: 15; W: 4.5 cm Narrow pulley, carved with an anthropomorphic face whose chin is included in the stirrup and whose neck is slightly ringed. Its eyes are shaped like coffee beans and its ears like cups.
