### Description

An eighteenth-century Hague (Den Haag) decorated Tournai porcelain small plate, circa 1780, with scalloped edge, central landscape with a building and figures, the lip decorated with baskets of flowers in gilt and enamel and gilt lace. Marks: Undergaze blue painted stork mark. Incised "6", "9", or "g". Measurements: Diameter: 18cm (7.1 in) Height: 2.5 cm (1.0 in) Condition: Excellent for age and type. Minimal wear to decoration and gilding, and no surface scratches or crazing. No restoration found under examination with ultraviolet light. Notes: Owned by the Lyncker family, the Hague (Den Haag) Porcelain Factory did not manufacture its own porcelain and instead decorated blanks it bought mainly from the Tournai and Ansbach factories.
