France, late 16th century, Large sculpture of a Bishop (H 140 cm) This very large wooden sculpture of a Bishop Saint is a 16th-century work from northern France. Wearing a mitre, he sports a long cassock with deep folds and, with his missing left hand, holds the end of a long cope with wide folds, revealing his rounded shoes. With his right hand, he makes the gesture of blessing. These garments with their pronounced folds and the shape of the shoes are characteristic of the Gothic style. This Bishop Saint faces us in a hieratic, frontal pose. His size gives him a very strong presence, accentuated by an expressive face with fine features, almond-shaped eyes, and a prominent nose. Highly decorative due to its size, and possessing a great simplicity that is its strength, this sculpture is suitable for both
