Each scene highlights a group of figures dressed in period costumes: women, children, and young boys engaged in everyday and playful activities in a warm and joyful atmosphere. The paintings display all the refinement of early painting: expressive faces, delicate drapery, a luminous palette of ochre and earth tones, and attention to detail in the rural architecture and surrounding vegetation.
