### Description

This work, signed L. Dupuy, a pseudonym used by Eugène Galien-Laloue, depicts a delicate view of a rural village, executed with the artist's characteristic finesse and sensitivity. In the foreground, a path bordered by dense, colorful vegetation leads the eye to a cluster of houses with ochre and brown roofs, nestled in the heart of a verdant landscape. The misty atmosphere and subtle nuances of the sky convey a soft morning or late afternoon light, bathing the scene in a quiet poetry. The balanced composition and muted palette--dominated by greens, browns, and pearl grays--testify to Galien-Laloue's talent for capturing the serenity of French rural landscapes, in contrast to his more animated urban scenes. This landscape, of intimate refinement, perfectly illustrates Galien-Laloue's bucolic vein. The artist
