Based on the popular "gendarme's hat" style model, this charming and very comfortable chair derives its originality from the pine cone decorations and its rose-red printed canvas upholstery in the style of Toile de Jouy, giving it a fresh and vibrant look. Ideal for furnishing a bedroom in a country house or an 18th-century estate in the Basque Country. The bergère is in very good condition, recently reupholstered with a feather cushion.
