SABRE known as Wakizashi Japan - Edo period (1603-1868) Steel, wood, lacquer, copper, horn, shakudo, gold, brass, silver, bone Nagasa: 33 cm; Nakago: 11 cm Sori: 1 cm? Shinogi Tsukuri blade, Mune Hikushi, Gunome-style Hamon. Kaeri Fukashi-style Boshi. Nakago Funa Gata and Ha Hagari Kuri Jiri. Copper Habaki covered with shakudo. Wooden Saya covered with black and red lacquer, ribbed in relief. Iron kojiri, chiselled with a Tsuchinoko snake embellished with gold. Kuri Gata made of bone. Koi Guchi made of lacquered buffalo horn. Tsuka ito made of wood, covered with shagreen. Kogatana with silver Kotsuka, chiselled with two men, one of whom is a samurai, all enhanced with shakudo, gold and silver. Menuki in copper covered with shakudo representing a rooster next to a den-den daiko, all
