This pendant is spectacular due to its large size, brilliance, and the craftsmanship of its setting. Entirely set with sparkling crystals or rhinestones, a stylized foliate knot motif is surmounted by a large round gemstone surrounded by two circles and supports a large, mobile, pear-shaped pendant. Its long bail allows for the passage of a velvet ribbon or a heavy chain. The reverse is almost as beautiful! A so-called "girandole" style, inspired by the 17th century, it dates from the 19th century and is hallmarked with a boar's head. PERFECT CONDITION! FRANCE, mid-19th century.
