### Description

A patinated bronze plaque with a finely chiseled relief reproduces the famous scene from the painting "Jews Praying in the Synagogue on Yom Kippur" (1878) by the Polish-Jewish painter Maurycy Gottlieb, a major figure in 19th-century realist art. It captures the spiritual depth and emotional power of the original: worshippers in prayer, faces filled with contemplation, and the subdued light of a synagogue interior. This work pays homage to the memory, faith, and culture of European Jews of the period. Based on the original 1878 work held at the Tel Aviv Museum of Art.
