The silver bolsters and ferrules are decorated with laurel wreaths and swans with outstretched wings. The knives are presented in a case that is not original but is nonetheless practical. The silver blades are hallmarked: Minerva 1st standard (pre-1973) for 950/1000 silver. Maker's mark: EP with a penknife for the Puiforcat company. The ferrules are not hallmarked but have been tested with a touchstone. A superb set of twelve knives for six guests, one of the finest Puiforcat Empire-style models. Table knives: 25 cm long 309 grams for six. Fruit knives: 20 cm long 195 grams for six. The handles are split, discreetly on the dessert knives,
