A single glance at this pastel immerses you in the distinctive world of Delphin Enjolras (1857-1945), the most emblematic painter of the Belle Époque, aptly nicknamed "the painter of reflections." He is the quintessential painter of bourgeois interiors and exteriors, of soft lighting and luxurious fabrics. He portrays elegant, languid young women, most often going about their daily lives, and invites us into a rare intimacy through his talent and technique, which make him a particularly admired and sought-after artist. For him, women were an inexhaustible source of inspiration. Delphin Enjolras was a student of Gaston Gérard, then of Jean-Léon
