Medieval floor tile from the Gravensteen Castle - Ghent, 14th-15th century

Rare red earthenware floor tile decorated with a heraldic lion, incised and inlaid with yellow slip under a transparent lead glaze.

Size : 15 × 15 cm, thickness 1.5 cm.

Excellent condition - complete tile with fine old patina.

Provenance: Gravensteen Castle, Ghent.

Unearthed during the restoration works led by architect Joseph de Waele between 1887 and 1893, when numerous medieval tiles were discovered.

A handwritten note on the back reads: "Tegel - Gravensteen Gent / Genaadig gegeven van Bompa / Kompare / voor Simone", indicating an early family gift originating from those
